» **Wings Etc.** (Avon, Brownsburg and Carmel locations). OK, I challenge anyone to say they are more of a chicken-wing connoisseur than I am. These wings are big and juicy, plus you get to pick your temperature for the sauce.

» **Some Guys** at 62nd Street and Allisonville Road. The staff is great. They have a wonderful lunch pizza and salad with a homemade bleu cheese dressing that is simply awesome.

» **Puccini's Smiling Teeth** (locations in Indianapolis, Carmel and Fishers). If you have never ordered the half order of garlic cheese bread, get it next time -- it is the best. Have fettuccini as the main dish with a side salad.

» **Sullivan's Steakhouse** (3316 E. 86th St.). The atmosphere is comfortable. My preference is a small fillet with a wedge salad.

» **St. Elmo Steak House** (127 S. Illinois St.). I like to take people who are new to Indy to St. Elmo. It's an institution, right? Then we set them up with that spicy horseradish sauce with the shrimp. It's amazing -- it blows people away.
